What to Podcast About?

ANYTHING

Elementary:

Write a short script about the topic you are teaching. In pairs or small groups, students read the script, add music, and download their podcast to turn in.

Middle School:

Have students read an anchor text, website, or other media. Students summarize the topic and information into a script, then record their podcast to teach others.

High School:

Students conduct research on a topic and identify the important information. Students create an introduction, summary, and conclusion and write a script. Record, add music, and turn in.
